The right exfoliator turned my complexion around. A chemical one works better for me than a scrub, so I use Philosophy's The Microdelivery Triple-Acid Brightening Peel (£59, philosophyskincare.co.uk). It makes everything you use after it work better.

I'm obsessed with eye creams. It started with a few little fine lines and now Dr Levy's Intense Stem Cell Eye Booster Concentrate (£165, 020 7460 7324) is

my hero. I give myself a mini eye massage when I apply it.

I hate the feeling of a cream on my skin during the day. SkinCeuticals' serums are a beauty ed's staple and my favourite is the antioxidant-packed Phloretin CF (£150, skinceuticals.co.uk).

Face masks are my go-to rescue remedies. Sisley's Black Rose Cream Mask (£95.50, sisley-paris.com) doesn't need to be washed off, so I'll apply it before a flight and let it do its thing.

It's not often I'm wowed by a brand, but I've fallen for Radical Skincare's Advanced Peptide Antioxidant Serum (£125, harrods.com). Why? It makes my skin look better – simple as that. It has some serious anti-ageing credentials, too.

I had a lash-extension habit a while back. When I weaned myself off them, I turned to RapidLash's

Eyelash Enhancing Serum (£37, boots.com) and I haven't looked back.

Paris pharmacies have lost their allure. Why? My top does-it-all cleanser – Bioderma's Micelle Solution for Sensitive Skin (£9.99, escentual.com) – has made it across the Channel. I use it to clean out my make-up bag, too.

I was never fussed about oils until Kiehl's brought out its Midnight Recovery Concentrate (£36, kiehls.co.uk). It sinks straight in.

Spots are my beauty bugbear and, I admit, I do pick. Vichy's Normaderm Hyaluspot (£10.50, boots.com) is my saviour. I'll alternate dabbing it onto the blemish with running an ice cube over the area.
